Notice Regarding Electronic Meetings

All local governing bodies in the State of Tennessee have been impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Germantown is no exception. In an effort to carry out its governance and operational responsibilities lawfully, and effectively, while also considering the protection of public health, safety and welfare, the Germantown City Administration has taken steps to conduct Board of Mayor and Aldermen and other public meetings electronically. These actions were taken in response to Governor Bill Lee's Executive Order 51, an order extending Executive Order 16, previously extended by Executive Order No. 34, which suspended the requirements of the Tennessee Open Meetings Act to the extent necessary to allow governing bodies subject to the act to meet and conduct essential business by electronic means.

The public will be able to view the video recording of the Parks and Recreation Commission virtual meeting within 24 hours of the meeting. These measures are temporary, and are due to expire on October 28, 2020, unless further action is taken by Governor Lee.
